Membership fees are not refundable for any reason at any time.

# Tuition and Fees

## Policies:

Tuition is posted to portals on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Tuition can be paid through your parent portal via card or using cash or check at the studio. When paying through your parent portal, additional credit card fees will be applied.

Late fees will be applied on the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month if tuition remains unpaid. A \$10 late fee PER class will be charged. Dancers will not be permitted to continue dancing if tuition remains unpaid for two months straight.

**Tuition is broken into 10 equal monthly payments for your convenience. Tuition remains the same regardless of how many lessons occur during that month. Knecht Dance ensures that each class receives the same amount of lessons from September to June.**

Families can choose to pay tuition less frequently. Choose the tuition payment plan that best fits your family using the tuition chart.

## Withdrawals and Refunds:

Tuition will continue to be charged until a "WITHDRAWAL NOTICE" form is completed via our website. If a dancer does not withdrawal, the family will still be responsible for any owed tuition or additional fees.

Tuition is not refunded or credited for any reason. If a dancer misses a class for whatever reason, they are welcome to make up the class at a later date. Families can email us or visit us at the desk for a complete list of appropriate makeup classes.



# Community Guidelines



## Onboarding

Upon registering for class, all dancers will receive their welcome packet. Grown ups must sign and return their studio waiver prior to their first class. Dancers will not be permitted to participate in class without a signed waiver. Grown ups should make sure they are able to log in to their portal and ensure that all information is up to date and correct. Knecht Dance is not responsible for any missed information throughout the season. Any issues regarding registration or parent portals can be emailed or brought up at our front desk.

## Placement

Students are placed in classes according to age, ability, and faculty discretion. Please remember that our directors and faculty are highly qualified and have every dancers' best interest at heart. Students are placed where we feel they will make the most personal progress. Any inquiries regarding placement can be emailed. Certain classes require prerequisites and approval by KD directors.

**\*Dancers must be enrolled in a corresponding ballet class to register for any lyrical class.**

**\*Dancers must be enrolled in a corresponding ballet class and at least 11 years of age to be considered for pointe class.**

Knecht Dance reserves the right to cancel, combine, or reschedule any weekly class at any time for any reason.

## Studio Etiquette

At Knecht Dance we strive to provide a positive environment for all who visit. We ask guardians to drop off and pick up dancers or wait in our lobby. We offer CCTV viewing for families while you wait. Grown ups are not permitted in the studios at any time unless invited by faculty. No one is permitted in any studio without a faculty member present. Grown ups interested in speaking with a faculty member should request an appointment at the front desk or via email. While in our lobby please refrain from speaking loudly, allowing siblings to disrupt classes, or distracting dancers from their teachers. Knecht Dance is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or misplaced items. If a dancer has lost an item, they can check out our LOST AND FOUND upon entering the building.

## Technology

Knecht Dance is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or misplaced items. Dancers are to keep any valuables in their dance bags and are encouraged to bring their dance bags into class. Phones/smart watches/devices are to be turned off for the duration of class. Dancers are not to check their devices at any time during class. If a teacher sees a device, they reserve the right to confiscate until the end of class. Knecht Dance offers free wi-fi to any families or dancers that wish to complete work while waiting in our lobby.

# Community Guidelines

## Dancer Etiquette

All students are expected to conduct themselves with the upmost respect for our faculty, directors, staff, other dancers, and of course themselves. Knecht Dance has a zero tolerance policy regarding bullying. Any dancer that disrespects their teachers, fellow students, or our property will be asked to leave. Dancers are asked to come to class 10-15 minutes early, ready to learn and work hard. Gum, food, and any drink besides water are strictly prohibited from the studios. If a mess is left in our lobby with food or drinks, the dancer responsible will not be permitted to bring food or drinks anymore. Vaping, drugs, or alcohol are strictly prohibited from the studio premises. Any dancer found with any substance will be immediately dismissed. Knecht Dance reserves the right to modify studio rules and policies at any time for any reason. Knecht Dance remains a safe space for all who dance here. Any dancer that represents the studio in a negative light in person or on social media will be immediately expelled.

## Studio Closures

Knecht Dance follows Hopewell Valley School District's closures and breaks while also working to ensure each class receives the same amount of lessons throughout the season. A complete list of scheduled breaks and studio closures can be found in THIS PACKET. This list is also posted on our bulletin board, in your parent portal, and at [knechtdance.com](http://knechtdance.com)

We ask that you follow us on all social media platforms. All studio closures and any cancelled classes will be posted on our Facebook, Instagram, and in your portals. Knecht Dance reserves the right to cancel or reschedule classes for any reason at any time.

## Missed or Canceled Classes

Tuition is not refunded or credited for any reason at any time. If a dancer misses a class for any reason, they are invited to make up in another class equal or below their current level. For a complete list of appropriate makeup classes, please visit the front desk or email us. If a teacher must miss a class, Knecht Dance will provide a qualified substitute. If a substitute cannot be found, class may be cancelled. Classes cancelled due to a teacher illness or unforeseen circumstance will be made up at a later date.

**Classes cancelled due to inclement weather will not be made up. Dancers can request a list of appropriate makeup classes.**

## Withdrawal

If a dancer chooses to withdrawal from class, **families must fill out withdrawal form via our website**. Until the studio receives written notice of withdrawal, families will be responsible for paying tuition- regardless of dancer's attendance in class. Tuition may not be paused at any time for any reason. If a dancer wishes to drop a class, they must pay a new registration fee if they choose to rejoin at any time.

# Community Guidelines

## Social Media

We strongly urge all our families to follow us on social media. Our Instagram and Facebook are updated daily. All important announcements, updates, or behind the scenes will be posted on our social media, website, and portal. Please make sure your email address is up to date in your account to ensure you receive any important announcements. We encourage our families to share and post any photos or videos from our KD classes and events. We ask that any choreography not be shared until the end of our season. If a family posts negatively about the studio in any way during their time at the studio, they will be asked to leave immediately.

## Recital

We celebrate the end of our season with our Annual Dance Festival. While this event is not mandatory, we encourage all our dancers and families to participate. This is an opportunity for our dancers to show all that they've worked on throughout the season and celebrate their growth. Our recital date is released as soon as it is confirmed with our venue and will be available in our member packet, website, bulletin board, and portal. More information regarding our recital can be found in our recital packet, released in January.

## Costumes

In order to participate in recital, dancers must purchase a recital costume for each class they participate in. Dancers are measured for costumes in October and costumes are ordered in November to ensure our dancers receive them in time for picture week and recital. **If a dancer drops before recital, they forfeit their costume for the season.** Costumes cannot be exchanged, refunded, or replaced for any reason. Costume fees will be added to portals on November 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Costumes for students in our GARDEN PROGRAM: \$90 per costume**

**Costumes for petite/junior/teen/senior students: \$100 per costume**

Costumes will not be purchased for dancers with an outstanding balance. Costumes are tried on in class when we receive them. Knecht Dance ensures all costumes fit appropriately, include any accessories, and look presentable prior to sending them home with dancers. Knecht Dance is not responsible for any costume once they are sent home.

Costume fees paid after December 1<sup>st</sup> will include a \$25 late fee PER COSTUME due to rushed delivery fees. Knecht Dance can never guarantee the arrival of a costume ordered after December 1<sup>st</sup>.

# Primary Classes

At Knecht Dance, all dancers in first grade or older are part of our Primary Program. These dancers meet once a week from September to June and participate in our Annual Dance Festival. Class placement is determined by age, level, and teacher discretion. Some classes may require director approval or a prerequisite. You can find all this information in our Community Guidelines.

Some class placements are determined by ability. These classes are labeled beginner, intermediate, advanced. In these classes, dancers may be on the same track ability wise but may be a mix of ages. As always, our priority is always the personal progress of each dancer.

## **BEGINNER**

Typically reserved for our petite and junior dancers. Dancers in beginner level are new to the style or have less than 3 years experience.

## **INTERMEDIATE**

Typically reserved for our junior and teen dancers. Dancers in intermediate level are knowledgeable in technique and terminology in specific style and have at least 3-5 years experience.

## **ADVANCED**

Typically reserved for our senior dancers. Dancers in advanced level are proficient in style and able to execute precise technique and artistry. Placement at teacher discretion,


